



## HEADLANDS & BEACH WALKING AND BIKE TRACKS

- Lennox Head 3.1 km
- Pat Moreton Lookout 2.3 km
- Boulders Beach 1.1 km (10 min walk)
- Sharpes Beach 1.9 km (15-20 min walk)
- Ballina 8 km



### Nearby Walks

- **Lennox Head Coastal Recreational Path** – Turn right at front entrance of park. Cross at Headlands Drive & continue following the path east toward roundabout. Cross at the pedestrian refuge & follow footpath to the left. A coastal boardwalk and bike track to the north of Skennars Head Road hugs the eastern side of the Coast Road & will connect you to Pat Moreton Lookout & the boardwalk to Lennox Head township
- **Lennox Head Coastal Walk** – Turn right at front of park. Cross at Headlands Drive & follow the path east toward roundabout. Cross at the pedestrian refuge & walk down Rocky Point Road. Follow the well-worn path to the north & you will enjoy an amazing coastal headland walk to Lennox Head. It is a grass & beach path with a relatively large incline near Pat Moreton.
- **Skennars Head Walk** – Turn right at front entrance of park. Cross at Headlands Drive & continue following the path east toward roundabout. Cross at the Pedestrian refuge and follow Rocky Point Road to Boulders Beach. The walking track across the headland of Skennars Head follows closely to the coastline and offers some spectacular photo opportunities & possible whale displays during the season (May to September). This is not a paved walk, but is a well-used grassed path. We recommend enclosed footwear. Good mountain bikers can use this path also. Round trip back is about 3 km.
- **Sharpes Beach Walk** – Turn right at front entrance of park. Continue on footpath until you cross Headlands Drive, then turn right. Follow the footpath running parallel to Headlands Drive. Just before Xavier school, turn left up the path which cuts through the estate, over the hill and towards Sharpes Beach. This path is paved & is suitable for bikes & prams. Relatively low incline, & no major roads to cross. Sharpes Beach is patrolled during school holidays.
- **Sharpes Beach Boardwalk** – A boardwalk has been built at the south end of Sharpes Beach carpark. This is a nice flat walk through to Flat Rock Beach, continues south toward Angels Beach and joins to the walking tracks of Ballina.
